Introduction to Payroll Based Journal - CMS

All SNF's will be required to submit electronic payroll data which will then be used for the CMS Nursing Home Compare and the Nursing Home Five Star Quality Rating system. The counting period will begin in the 4th quarter of this year July 1-September 30 and the first submission will be due by November 14, 2016.(Note that quarter data is not a typo-for PBJ our fourth quarter will be the July through September period). Why is this important to you and your facility?

- ACO's are crashing into our world as we speak. You may not have a choice of inclusion in an ACO if your 5 star rating falls below that ACO's criteria that results in Med A and Managed Care Admissions being challenged or you being removed from that market.
- The Nursing Home Compare Website now will have up to date data to publish on your staffing PPD's, including direct care staff per patient per day. Future data will include your turnover and retention information.
- 3. It is a new system to learn, manage and watch carefully that all staffing data is getting collected (did your MDS coordinator work as a charge nurse one day-how do you plan to capture those hours in direct care staffing?) Are you using agency staffing? How will they get included in your payroll journal? Do you cross train and have some housekeeping staff who occasionally work as CNA's? How will you assure their hours get included in your payroll journal?
- 4. There is a voluntary period going on right now that you can get the training and test drive the data you are inputting to see if it is painting an accurate picture or needs some review. Once the official counting period begins it does not look as if you'll have any test drive period.

While there are error submission reporting mechanisms we are not sure yet if they will change the master file data enough to make a difference. Therefore you may be stuck in that quarter, until the next submission, with inaccurate or wrong data driving your Five Star.

Don't miss this opportunity to get a head start and move into PBJ with confidence. This is one you'll want to bring your DON and Payroll Manager with you so you can all hear it and debate it together.
